We met Pres A. H. Sund and had some conversation with him. He asked us if we was willing and ready to go on mission to Iceland our reply was yes, we was ready to go if we was wanted, but I told him about my age and condition, but he said that he like us both to go to gether and that we will help one another, but nothing more was said. We then went home, with out any further perperation for mission to Iceland but on the 12 of April we both received Call to go to Iceland and if we was willing and ready we should leave Salt Lake City on June 11. In our reply we accepted the Call and made our self ready to go and comply with the Call.

I sold my Team harness and Wagon for \$275.00 also I sold my Bees 40 Stands for \$275.00. I also had an Interest \$200.00 altogether \$750.00 I had then paid in full for my House in Town \$700.00 which I bought of my son Elias. I put \$200.00 in Cleveland Co-op for my wifes suport while on mission and \$25.00 in Cash I left with her, at the farwell part held on the evening of May 31<sup>st</sup> I received \$51.35.

On the June 4<sup>th</sup> B. H. my oldest son together with his wife and Children and Helga and Erick and my wife took me to Price we com there 1:30 p.m. we went to our daughter Lillie Smith and Brother Erick and other of the family went home at 4 P.M.
